### CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Arguably the world's most esteemed premium red grape variety, Cabernet Sauvignon grown in the best California vineyards produces grapes of considerable concentration and finesse. The wines are typically full-bodied and intense, with lasting flavor. "Ripe black cherry and cedar aromas combine with rich Cabernet grape flavors and notes of vanilla oak. Velvety and soft yet intense on the palate, with a long smooth finish. Enjoy with grilled game birds, poultry, sausages, mild cheese and lighter Southwestern fare."

Richly flavored with its black currant and mint aromas. Velvety and soft yet intense on the palate, and lingering berry flavors.

### SAUVIGNON BLANC

Fumé Blanc is a widely used alternate name for the Sauvignon Blanc grape variety. Particularly when it is grown in prime vineyards along the California coast, this highly regarded grape produces outstanding dry white wines, most often with a fresh, slightly herbaceous character. "A classic and elegant white wine."

#### TASTING NOTES

Earth and flintstone nose with green apple and lush vanilla oak flavors; smooth on the palate, with a long, crisp finish.

### WHITE ZINFANDEL

A small number of red grape varieties can be vinified to produce attractive "blush" or white wines, and Zinfandel is the most popular. White Zinfandel takes advantage of the grape's intensity of berry-like flavor and its appealing, brilliant color.

#### TASTING NOTES

A delicate wine of light salmon color with hints of ripe pear and rich Zinfandel flavors; delightfully fruity and soft on the palate, with a clean, smooth finish.

### MERLOT

Merlot, a grape variety of major importance in Bordeaux, has come into fashion in California during the last twenty years. The reason is that the wine at its best has distinctly fruity aromas and flavors, and in its youth is typically rounder and more supple than Cabernet Sauvignon. "Rich black cherry aromas are followed by lush fruit flavors with hints of mint and vanilla. Full-bodied in the classic Merlot style, this wine is soft on the palate, with a long finish. An excellent companion to lamb, beef, or hearty pasta dishes."

### CHARDONNAY

Chardonnay, America's most popular white wine grape, produces wines of elegance and finesse. The classic Chardonnay flavor association is apple-like, but oak ageing often changes the tastes toward peach or pineapple, always with attractive richness on the palate. "Balanced ageing in stainless steel and small oak barrels creates a supple, full-flavored Chardonnay. Straw-gold color; subtle citrus and oak aromas and a long, crisp finish. Excellent as 'a wine by the glass' and with pasta, mild ripe cheeses and shellfish."

#### TASTING NOTES

Balanced aging in stainless steel and small oak barrels creates a supple, full-flavored Chardonnay. Straw gold color; bright citrus and pineapple aromas, rich texture in the mouth and a long, creamy finish.
